

Numatic International Sustainability Policy

Objective

Numatic International recognises that we cannot continue to produce top-class cleaning equipment without addressing the environmental impact of our products and operations. Numatic International has approved near-term and long-term science-based emissions reduction targets with the SBTi.

Numatic International Ltd commits to reduce absolute scope 1, 2 and 3 GHG emissions 63.0% by 2035 from a 2024 base year.

Numatic International Ltd commits to reduce absolute scope 1, 2 and 3 GHG emissions 90.0% by 2050 from a 2024 base year

We will embark on a programme of work to address all aspects of our product's lifecycle and prioritise decarbonisation and all residual emissions will be neutralised in line with SBTi criteria. We intend to lead in the cleaning appliance sector. This policy document sets out how we will make a positive contribution to global climate action through changes in the way we manufacture products and the materials that we use.

Scope and Context

The scope of this policy covers the operations of our manufacturing site situated in Chard, Somerset, UK and all aspects of its products from raw materials and component procurement to the use phase and end-of-life management.

- We commit to achieving net-zero greenhouse gas emissions across the value chain by 2050.
- We will take action to develop our Decarbonisation Strategy to reach our goals as stated.
- We will deliver action in the short term wherever opportunities exist.
- We will seek continual improvement of our processes, products, infrastructure and the way we conduct our business.
- We will measure and monitor our progress, adjusting our strategy to the latest science.
- We will publicly report our progress annually.
- We will assess all business projects and capital expenditure to ensure sustainability aspects have been considered.
- We will evaluate climate-related risks and grow resilience to protect our business.
- We will comply with or exceed applicable climate-related obligations and other requirements to which Numatic International subscribes.
- We will undertake to set an example of leadership in the field of climate action.

- Reduce Gas kWh/Unit by 5%
- Reduce Electricity kWh/Unit by 5%
- Reduce Annual Non-Recyclable Waste by 8.5%
- Increase from 25% to 35% Recycled Plastics Purchased
- Reduce Plastic Packaging by 7%
